

✂ Little Miss Sunshine ✂

Net bag



Yarn: Mayflower Cotton 8 (50 gr ≈ 170m), color 1404. Approx 340 metres

Hook: 3,5 mm

Abbreviations (US):

sl st	slip stitch
ch	chain
sc	single crochet
dc	double crochet
dc tog	double crochets together
ch sp	chain space

Notes:

- ♥ Ch 3 at beginning of row = 1 dc
- ♥ End each row with a sl st in 1st st
- ♥ Repeat *-* to end of row
- ♥ The bag is crocheted in one piece starting from the bottom and up

Row 1: Chain 5, 1 sl st in 1st st to form a ring. 16 dc around the ring

Row 2: *3 dc in the same st, ch 1, skip 1 st* (8 dc clusters)

Row 3: *2 dc in 1st st in cluster, 1 dc in 2nd st, 2 dc in 3rd st, ch 2*

Row 4: *1 dc in each dc in cluster, ch 3*

Row 5: *2 dc tog, 1 dc, 2 dc tog, ch 3, 1 dc around ch sp, ch 3*

Row 6: *3 dc tog, ch 2, 1 dc around ch sp, ch 1, [1 dc+ch 2+1 dc] in the single dc, ch 1, 1 dc around next ch sp, ch 2*

Row 7: *[2 dc+ch 2+2 dc] in dc cluster, ch 1, skip 1 ch sp, 1 dc in dc, ch 1, skip 1 ch sp, [2 dc+ch 2+ 2dc] around next ch sp, ch 1, skip 1 ch sp, 1 dc in dc, ch 1, skip 1 ch sp*

Row 8: Sl st to 1st ch sp, *[2 dc+ch 2+2dc] around ch sp between 2 dc clusters, ch 1, 1 dc in the single dc, ch 1*

Row 9: Sl st to 1st ch sp *[2 dc+ch 2+2dc] around ch sp between 2 dc clusters, ch 1, [1dc+ch 2+1 dc] in the single dc, ch 1*

Row 10: Sl st to 1st ch sp *[2 dc+ch 2+2 dc] around ch sp between 2 dc clusters, ch 1, [1dc+ch 2+1dc] around next ch 2-sp, ch 1*

Row 11-15: = row 10

Row 16: Sl st to 1st ch sp, [2 dc tog+ch 1+2 dc tog] around ch sp, *[2 dc tog+ch 1+2 dc tog] around next ch sp*

Row 17: *ch 4, skip 1st and 2nd dc cluster, 1 sl st *between* 2nd and 3rd cluster* (as shown in picture)



Row 17

Row 18: Sl st to middle of 1st ch sp, ch 4, *1 sl st around next ch sp, ch 4*. End row with 1 sl st in 1st ch (32 ch sp)

Repeat row 18 32 more times, or to desired size (please note that the bag stretches with use). Do not cut yarn.

Edging and handles

Row 1: 3 dc around each ch sp (=96 dc)

Row 2: 1 sc in each st

Row 3 1 dc in each st

Row 4: = row 2

Row 5: 5 dc, ch 30 (add more chains if you want longer handles), skip 20 st, 28 dc, ch 30, skip 20 st, 23 dc

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Row 6: 1 sc in each dc and in each ch

Row 7: 1 dc in each st

Row 8: 1 sl st in each st

Fasten off. Weave in all ends.

Optional: You can make a drawstring by making a long chain and thread between the dc:s on row 3 of the border.



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
