



Very Merry

Christmas stocking

Yarn: Netto Christmas yarn (worsted weight), or similar

Hook: 4,0 mm

Storlek: Height, approx 35 cm. Width (toe - heel), approx 25 cm

Colors: A – gray (approx 93 meters)
 B – red (approx 93 meters)
 C – green (approx 40 meters)
 D – white (approx 40 meters)

Abbreviations (US terms)

st	stitch
ch	chain
sl st	slip stitch
sc	single crochet
dc	double crochet
dc gr	double crochet group
2 in 1	2 sc in the same st (increase)
2>1	single crochet 2 together (decrease)
* - *	repeat
sk	skip

Notes

- The stocking is made of 2 identical panels joined together. After joining the panels you make the border around the top edge of the stocking
- Stitch count is showed in () after each row
- Chains at the end of a row are turning chains. Do not count as a st
- Make your color changes at the last pull through on the last st on a row, before making the turning chains
- Make sure you weave in all ends on the wrong side of the panels. They are worked flat in rows, so you have to choose which side is which

Panel (make 2)

Toe

Color A

Row 1: Magic ring, 4 sc into the ring, ch 1, turn (4)

Row 2: 2 sc in each st, ch 1, turn (8)

Row 3: *1 sc, 2 in 1*, ch 1, turn (12)

Row 4: *2 sc, 2 in 1*, ch 1, turn (16)

Row 5: *3 sc, 2 in 1*, ch 1, turn (20)

Row 6: *4 sc, 2 in 1*, ch 1 (24)

Row 7: Work 12 sc evenly spaced across the straight edge of the semicircle, ch 1, turn (12)

Rows 8-9: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn (12)



Foot

Color B

Row 10: 11 sc, 2 in 1, ch 1, turn (13)

Row 11: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn (13)

Row 12: 12 sc, 2 in 1, ch 1, turn (14)

Row 13: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn (14)

Row 14: 13 sc, 2 in 1, ch 1, turn (15)

Row 15: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn (15)

Row 16: 14 sc, 2 in 1, ch 1, turn (16)

Row 17: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn (16)

Row 18: 14 sc, *2 in 1* 2 times, ch 1, turn (18)

Rows 19-33: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn (18)



Heel

Color A/B

Do not cut yarn between the color changes on rows 34-40

Row 34: 10 sc in color A. Change to color B, 8 sc, ch 1, turn (18)

Row 35: 8 sc. Change to color A, 10 sc, ch 1, turn (18)

Repeat rows 34-35 3 more times

Row 36: Repeat row 34

Row 37: 8 sc. Change to color A, 8 sc, 2>1, ch 1, turn (17)

Row 38: 2>1, 7 sc. Change to color B, 8 sc, ch 1, turn (16)

Row 39: 8 sc. Change to color A, 6 sc, 2>1, ch 1, turn (15)

Row 40: 2>1, 5 sc. Change to color B, 8 sc, ch 1 (14)

Row 41: Work 26 sc evenly spaced across the top edge up until row 18, ch 1, turn (26)



Leg

Color C

Row 42: 1 sc in each st, ch 2, turn (26)

Row 43: 1 dc in each st, ch 1, turn (26)

Row 44: 1 sc in each st, ch 2, turn (26)

Row 45: 1 dc in each st, ch 1, turn (26)

Color D

Repeat rows 42-45



Color A

Repeat rows 42-45

Color B

Repeat rows 42-45

Color C

Repeat rows 42-45

Color D

Repeat rows 42-45

Color A

Repeat rows 42-45

Cut yarn, weave in all ends

Assembly

Place the panels with the wrong sides together

Color B

Starting at the top front corner of the leg, join the panels with sc around. Leave the top edge. Cut yarn



Border (work in the round)

Color A

Round 1: Start in any st. The first st is a standing sc. Work 52 sc around, join with a sl st to the first st, ch 1 (52)

Flip your work and work all following rounds with the wrong side of your work facing you.

Round 2: 1 sc in each st in back loop only. Join with a sl st to the first sc (52)

Rounds 3-5: ch 2 (=1 dc), 51 dc. Join with a sl st to the first st (52)

Round 6: ch 1 (=1 sc), 51 sc. Join with a sl st to the first st (52)



Color B

Round 7: Start in any st, *1 sl st, sk 1 st, 5 dc in the same st, sk 1 st*, join with a sl st to the first st (13 dc gr)

Color C

Round 8: Start in the first dc in any dc gr. The first st is a standing sc. *5 sc in back loop only, 1 sc between dc groups in the sc on row 6*, join with a sl st to the first st

Cut yarn. Weave in the ends. Fold down the border

Hanger

Color A

Ch 25

Row 1: Start in the 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn

Row 2: 1 sc in each st, ch 1, turn

Row 3: 1 sl st in each st. Cut yarn but leave a long tail and sew the hanger on to the stocking
