



My Butterfly Garden

Rectangular shawl

Yarn:

Body: approx 800 meters of Rico Creative Cotton Dégradé (fingering/sport weight), color 009

Border: approx 340 meters of Svarta Fåret Tilda (sport weight), color 61

Hook: 4.0 mm

Size: approx 168 x 52 cm

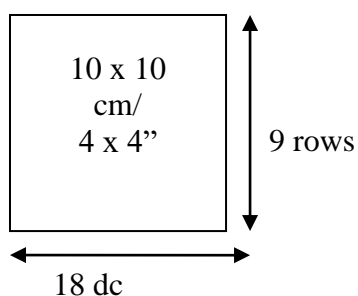
1 pattern repeat = approx 15 cm

Border = approx 19 cm

You can customize the length of the shawl by making more or fewer repeats.

Note that the amount of yarn needed may be different. See instructions below if you want to customize the length of the border.

Gauge



Abbreviations (US terms)

st	stitch	dc2tog	double crochet 2 together
sl st	slip stitch	2dc cl	2 double crochet cluster
ch	chain	tr	triple crochet
ch sp	chain space	picot	ch 3, sl st in 1 st ch
sc	single crochet	blo	back loop only
hdc	half double crochet	[-]	work in the same st
dc	double crochet	* - *	repeat

Notes

- Chains at the end of rows 1-17 (shown in italics) are turning chains. They do not count as stitches
- Stitch count in () at the end of each row
- Odd numbered rows = right side, even numbered rows = wrong side
- I recommend that you block your finished piece for best results

Ch 106 *loosely*

Row 1: Start in the 3rd ch from hook, 1 dc in each st, *ch 2*, turn (104 dc, do not count the initial ch 2)

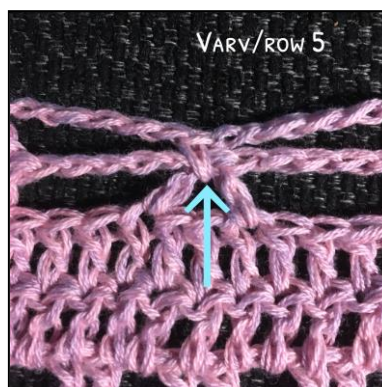
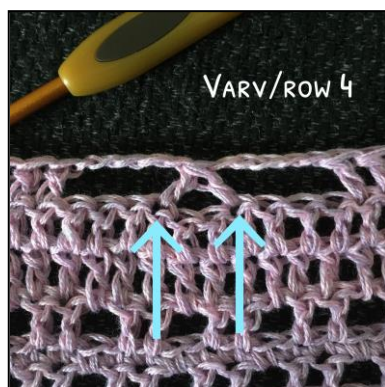
Rows 2-3: 1 dc in each st, *ch 2*, turn (104 dc)



Rows 4-8

Row 4: 5 dc, *ch 5, skip 3 st, work 1 dc2tog as follows (*see also pic below*): work the 1st dc in the next st, skip 2 st, work the 2nd dc in the next st after the 2

skipped, ch 5, skip 3 st, 4 dc* 7 times, 1 dc in the last st, ch 2, turn (34 dc, 7 dc2tog, 14 ch sp)



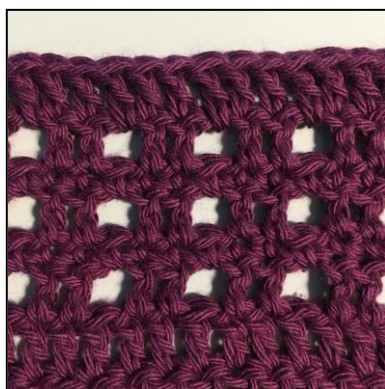
Row 5: 5 dc, *ch 6, skip ch sp, 1 sc around the space between the 2 dc in dc2tog, ch 6, skip ch sp, 4 dc*, 7 times, 1 dc in the last st, ch 2, turn (34 dc, 7 sc, 14 ch sp)

Row 6: 5 dc, *ch 6, skip ch sp, 1 sc in sc, ch 6, skip ch sp, 4 dc*, 7 times, 1 dc in the last st, ch 2, turn (34 dc, 7 sc, 14 ch sp)

Row 7: 5 dc, *ch 4, skip ch sp, [1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc] in sc, ch 4, skip ch sp, 4 dc* 7 times, 1 dc in the last st, ch 2, turn (48 dc, 7 ch-2 sp, 14 ch-4 sp)

Row 8: 5 dc, *4 dc in ch-4 sp, skip dc, 2 dc in ch-2 sp, skip dc, 4 dc in ch-4 sp, 4 dc* 7 times, 1 dc in the last st, ch 2, turn (104 dc)

Rows 9-10: 1 dc in each st, ch 2, turn (104 dc)



Rows
11-16

Row 11: 5 dc, *ch 1, skip 1 st, 2 dc* 31 times, ch 1, skip 1 st, 5 dc, *ch 1*, turn
(72 dc, 32 ch sp)

Row 12: 1 sc in each dc and each ch sp, *ch 2*, turn (104 sc)

Row 13: = row 11

Row 14: = row 12

Row 15: 5 dc, *ch 1, skip 1 st, 2 dc* 31 times, ch 1, skip 1 st, 5 dc, *ch 2*, turn
(72 dc, 32 ch sp)

Row 16: 1 dc in each dc and each ch sp, *ch 2*, turn (104 dc)

Row 17: 1 dc in each st, *ch 2*, turn (104 dc)

Repeat rows 4 – 17 (=1 pattern repeat) 7 more times

Repeat rows 4-10 x 1

Repeat row 9 x 1 (skip the ch 2 at end of row)

Your work should now measure approx 120 cm in length and consist of 9 sections of butterflies

Cut yarn, weave in the ends



Border

- Work across the short sides of the shawl
- You can customize the length of the border by skipping rows 3-12
- Start on the right side. Turn your work after each row

Row 1: *The 1st st is worked as a standing st.* 1 sc in each st (104 sc)

Row 2: *The 1st dc in the 1st dc2tog is replaced by ch 2.* 1 dc2tog over the first 2 st, *ch 2, skip 1 st, 1 dc2tog over the next 2 st* 34 times (35 dc2tog, 34 ch sp)

Row 3: ch 3 (=1 dc), [1 2dc cl, ch 1, 1 2dc cl] in the 1st ch sp, *[1 2dc cl, ch 1, 1 2dc cl] in the next ch sp* 33 times, 1 dc in the last dc2tog (68 2dc cl, 34 ch sp, 2 dc)

Rows 4-8: ch 3 (= 1 dc), [1 2dc cl, ch 1, 1 2dc cl] in ch sp, *[1 2dc cl, ch 1, 1 2dc cl] in the next ch sp* 33 times, 1 dc in the last dc (68 2dc cl, 34 ch sp, 2 dc)

Row 9: ch 4 (=1 tr), 3 tr in each ch sp, 1 tr in the last dc (104 tr)

Row 10: ch 1 (=1 sc), 1 sc in each st across (104 sc)

Row 11: ch 2 (= 1 hdc), 1 hdc *in blo* in each st across (104 hdc)

Row 12: = row 2

Row 13: ch 3 (=1 dc), [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in the 1st ch sp, *[1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in the next ch sp* 32 times, [1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in last ch sp, 1 dc in dc2tog (102 dc, 98 ch sp)

Row 14: ch 3 (=1 dc), skip 1 dc, 1 dc in the 1st ch sp, * skip 2 dc, [1 dc, ch 4, 1 dc] in the next dc* 32 times, skip 2 dc, 1 dc in last ch sp, skip 1 dc, 1 dc in the last dc (68 dc, 32 ch sp)

Row 15: ch 5 (=1 dc+ch 2), 1 sc in ch sp, *ch 5, 1 sc in the next ch sp* 31 times, ch 2, 1 dc in the last dc (33 ch sp, 32 sc, 2 dc)

Row 16: ch 1 (=1 sc), 1 sc in the 1st ch sp, *[1 dc, ch 1*, 4 times, 1 dc] in the next ch sp, 1 sc in the next ch sp* 16 times, 1 sc in the last dc (19 sc, 80 dc, 64 ch sp)

Row 17: ch 1 (=1 sc), sl st in sc, * *1 sc in dc, 1 sc in ch sp* 2 times, picot, skip dc, *1 sc in ch sp, 1 sc in dc* 2 times, sl st in sc* 16 times, 1 sc in the last sc (130 sc, 16 picot)

Cut yarn. Repeat across the other short side.



Cut yarn, weave in all ends. Block your finished work.
